Due Diligence

What is due diligence?

Due diligence or DD is an independent evaluation of the historical and forecast financial performance of a company. DD can be carried out on a prospective acquisition, buyer or partner.

Reasons you may need DD

- Acquisition (Buy side)
- Bespoke diligence
- Vendor-driven sale process (Sell side)
- Financing or Re-financing
- Tax due diligence

How can DD help you?

It can tackle issues early by uncovering information;

- that could be used to negotiate price

- which may aid the tax and financing structure
- upon which transaction terms may be based
- for which protection in the form of warranties or indemnities may be required

Consultation

Initial free consultation to identify the rationale for the potential transaction, key value drivers for the acquirer or funder and key risk areas to be addressed.



Scoping

Jointly agree a scope of work that will give you peace of mind and is achievable in the given time frame.



Information gathering

Work with management, be it the target or the vendor's, to gather meaningful data. Host discussions with senior management to understand the core operational issues facing the Company.



Analysis

Extract pertinent and relevant insights from the information gathered and communicate findings to you in real-time.



Report

Prepare a report that summarises our findings from the DD process in a plain speaking manner.

Financial Due Diligence (FDD)

As part of our FDD we would consider:

- the sustainability of the target's business plan, vision and strategic alliances;
- the financials including assets, liabilities, cash flow, revenues, associated costs and appropriateness of accounting policies;
- the target's competitors to provide an overview of your market environment and significant competitors;
- the management team to assess their capability and the organisational culture;
- the organisational infrastructure to review of facilities and systems, personnel talent and associated policies;
- the technology to identify any technological advances that the target has over its competitors; and
- the existing market potential

Tax Due Diligence (TDD)

Understanding the target's tax position, their attitude towards compliance is equally important when assessing the associated risks of a potential investment opportunity. Our TDD will generally focus on the:

- Tax compliance across Corporation Tax, Employment Taxes and VAT is up to date with filings and payments
- Previous transactions and reorganisations are reviewed to assess potential risks
- Identify opportunities to maximise tax efficiencies as part of the acquisition process and future integration

As with all businesses there may be other taxes which require consideration which we will scope out with you during our initial discussions.
